

# Brexit Timeline

**23 July 2019**

- Boris Johnson elected as leader of Conservative Party and becomes UK Prime Minister.

**19 October 2019**

- Prime Minister sends letters to the EU requesting an extension under the EU (Withdrawal) (No 2) Act 2019.

**30 October 2019**

- Parliament agrees to early general elections.

**31 January 2020**

- Anticipated exit date under the legislation to prevent a no deal Brexit on October 2019.

**? - 31 December 2020 (?)**

- Transition period per the Withdrawal Agreement - starts on the day agreement enters into force. Note an extension to 31 December 2021 or 2022 may be agreed.

**7/18 October 2019**

- European Council meeting.

**28 October 2019**

- EU grants extension of Brexit to maximum 31 Januari 2020.

**12 December 2019**

- Potential date for UK General Election.

**12/13 December 2019**

- European Council meeting.

**31 July 2020**

- Review of progress on free trade agreement.
